rabbi's corner



Rabbi Aviva Bass

here is a story in the Talmud about Rabbi Akiva, a First Century rabbinic sage, and his students. According to this legend, 24,000 students of Rabbi Akiva died in a terrible plague, during the Omer period between Pesach and Shavuot. On the 33rd day of the Omer, Lag Ba'Omer, the plague ceased. There were only five students of Rabbi Akiva remaining. One of these was Rabbi Shimon bar Yochai, the Rashbi, to whom is attributed the Zohar, the seminal work of kabbalah, Jewish mysticism.

The Rashbi survived by hiding in a cave in the Galilee with his son. The legend is that they lived in that cave for 12 years, during which he studied the deepest mysteries of the Torah and received the teaching that he wrote in the Zohar. When he and his son emerged from the cave after those dozen years, they saw Jews occupying themselves with agriculture instead of Torah study, and the Rashbi became enraged. He looked at everyone and everything going about their daily lives, and his rage was so

powerful that his very glance killed all he looked upon. At that moment, a Bat Kol, a heavenly voice came down and said to him "Did you emerge from your cave to destroy my world? Return to your cave!" According to this story, Rashbi returned to the cave with his son, saying, "You and I are all that are necessary for the entire world."

We are beginning to emerge from our caves of the past 15 months of the pandemic, our terrible plague which has killed so many in our country and the world, and which is ongoing and raging in some areas of the world. We, the survivors, are trying to emerge from our caves into some feeling of normalcy. Some of us look upon others who are making different choices in their reemergence than we are, and we sometimes become frustrated, even perhaps enraged. What this story teaches us is not that we should return to our caves to live out the remainder of our lives within our own households, but rather what the Bat Kol says to the Rashbi.

Do we emerge from our caves just to continue the way we have been without having learned anything from our sequestering? Did we not learn how much we rely on one another, on outside contact, on socialization? We cannot afford to

become dismissive of one another. We need to celebrate being able to congregate in whatever ways each of us feels comfortable and not to judge each other's decisions.

As we reemerge after our hibernation, it takes a while to get our bearings. We may make one decision one day and another the next, as we navigate what it means to be fully vaccinated in a world in which COVID numbers may vacillate and some people, both those fully vaccinated and those who refuse to get vaccines, may be unmasked.

It is new territory for all of us. But I ask you not to give in to the impulse to return to your cave altogether. We need one another more than ever. And I look forward to greeting each of you as you become ready to reemerge.

SAVE ON TAXES?

You can **avoid taxes and save money** by having a distribution from your Individual Retirement Account **(IRA)** sent directly to Temple Sinai. The donation can be used to pay dues, towards a temple project or as a general donation (this can be used by the Temple as needed). The funds must be sent as a Qualified Charitable Distribution **(QCD)**. **Contact us** about your plans, then ask your IRA trustee or custodian how to proceed.

You can **avoid capital gains** taxes on appreciated shares of stock that you own by donating the shares to Temple Sinai. As above, the money can be used for any temple bill, project or as a general donation.

Contact us and we will give you instructions on what to tell your broker. After the shares are transferred to our account, we will sell them and credit your account for the net proceeds (after the fees and expenses are paid). If you have stock that you don't want to sell because of the taxes, this is a win/win for both you and Temple Sinai.

You should realize savings even if you don't itemize. If you do, it shouldn't count as income AND you should be able to take the deduction. As with any financial matter, you should consult your own financial representative or tax advisor to see if these techniques will benefit you.


