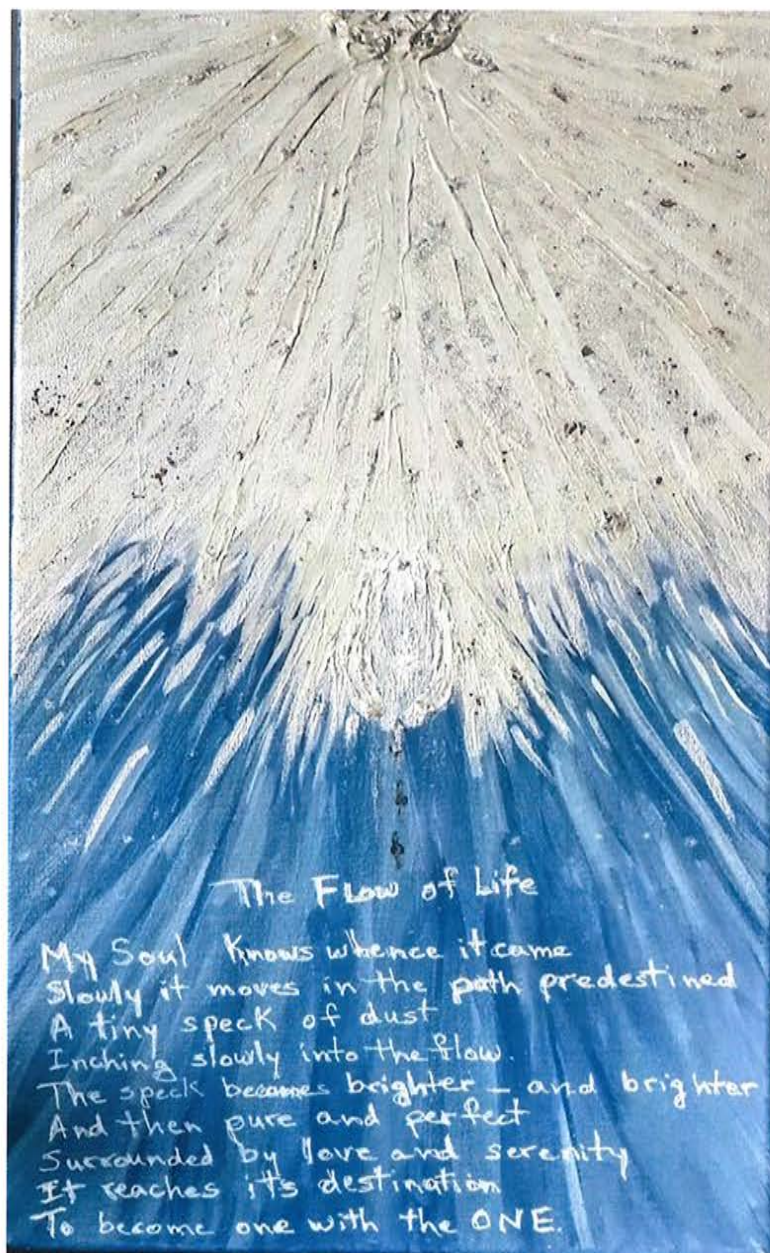

Sing to God a new song... (Psalm 96:1)

My father has always said that I could have been an amazing IT professional. From running Zoom/WebEx workshops to electronics repair, I love everything tech related. Some of you have inquired about the rabbi and me using iPads on the bimah, so I thought I would give you a peek behind the scenes.

Back in 2009, when I was working with my cantor-mentor in St. Louis, I made a custom songbook for my temple that included all the music that we would normally sing during services. My goal was to simplify the process of preparing and organizing the music each week. No longer would we constantly need to make photocopies or go searching through countless stacks of music. I even had this *shiron* (songbook) professionally printed and bound. It was beautiful but flawed. I had not solved the core issue at hand; how to create a central “database” of music that could be regularly updated. My cantor already had a folder on his computer with numerous PDF's, digital documents, of scanned sheet music which we used to make it easier to print copies. If only we could carry that computer file around with us.

A year later the first iPad came out, and that sparked an idea. Like me, my cantor was a technology nerd (a term which has been reclaimed as a badge of pride and group identity), and we had both bought the new Apple device. It was now so easy to put all the digital sheet music onto the iPad and organize setlists for services. As the iPad platform increased in popularity new apps specifically designed for displaying and organizing sheet music were developed making the process even easier.

Today, I can send new sheet music to the rabbi or an entire service to our accompanist, Dr. Macfarlane, in seconds. I can even include handwritten notes and edits. The digital sheet music trend has even spread to the heart of music in the Reform Jewish world, Transcontinental Music Publications. They have digitized nearly their entire back catalogue and offer instant, high quality digital downloads of new publications.

This trend of using iPads for sheet music is worldwide. From world famous philharmonic orchestras to Broadway, many musicians are switching to iPads. It is even now possible to link iPads to display multiple pages at once. There are even environmental and economic incentive: less paper wasted, no shipping costs or waiting, and publishers don't have to spend so much on printing which saves money and passes it on to the customer or composer. Even prayerbooks are going digital.

If you are curious about my iPads or have any IT questions just let me know. Until next time *chaverim* (friends).

**A message from Jeff Morgenstern,
Executive Director, Spanish River Concerts**

“As I have promised since the rollout of this season, our subscribers bear no risk by purchasing tickets from us. If conditions prevent us from proceeding with any of our planned concerts, or even if individuals change their minds about attending, we will refund any unused tickets – no questions asked. Our federal grant guarantees our solvency through 2022, and ensures our ability to make good on our promises, so you can rest easy knowing that you won’t lose any money by riding things out as we see how the next few months play out.

In my opinion, we are taking every reasonable precaution to lower exposure risk at our events; but I want to emphatically state that I do not encourage severely immunocompromised or otherwise at-risk individuals to attend our events.”

To help ensure the safety of all, Spanish River Concerts requires Proof of Vaccination (including the booster) to attend any of our events. We are requesting all attendees submit a copy of their Vaccination Cards prior to the start of the concert season to streamline the check-in process.

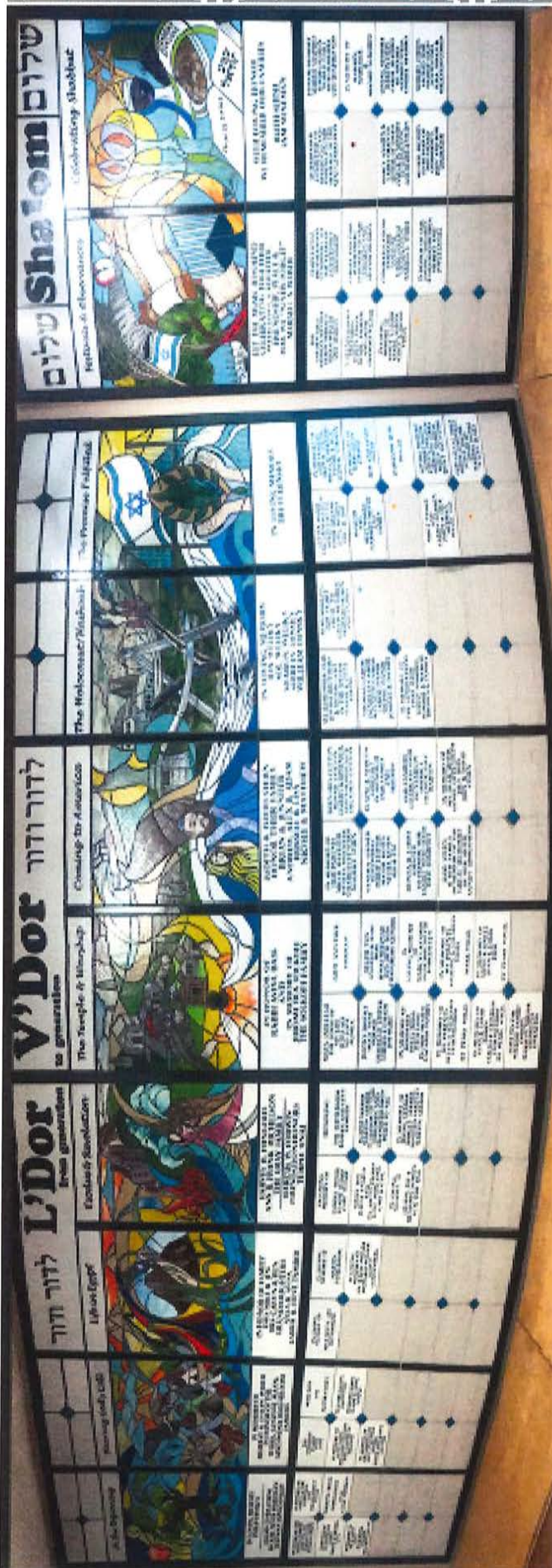

- Name and date of the deceased (before or after sundown)
- Time and place of the funeral or memorial service
- Time and address of the Shiva following the funeral or memorial service
- Information on where to make a donation in memory of the deceased

Let your Temple Family be there for your sorrows as well as your Simchas.



SAVE ON TAXES?

You can **avoid taxes and save money** by having a distribution from your Individual Retirement Account (**IRA**) sent directly to Temple Sinai. The donation can be used to pay dues, towards a temple project or as a general donation (this can be used by the Temple as needed). The funds must be sent as a Qualified Charitable Distribution (**QCD**). **Contact us** about your plans, then ask your IRA trustee or custodian how to proceed.

You can **avoid capital gains taxes** on appreciated shares of stock that you own by donating the shares to Temple Sinai. As above, the money can be used for any temple bill, project or as a general donation.

Contact us and we will give you instructions on what to tell your broker. After the shares are transferred to our account, we will sell them and credit your account for the net proceeds (after the fees and expenses are paid). If you have stock that you don't want to sell because of the taxes, this is a win/win for both you and Temple Sinai.

You should realize savings even if you don't itemize. *If you do, it shouldn't count as income AND you should be able to take the deduction.* As with any financial matter, you should consult your own financial representative or tax advisor to see if these techniques will benefit you.
