### rabbi's corner



Rabbi Aviva Bass

Dear Friends,

It is with bittersweet feelings that I write this, my last Tablet article for Temple Sinai. I have been the rabbi at Temple Sinai of Palm Beach County for almost six and a half years now, and I have had the blessing and privilege to get to know many of you well. I have been with many of you while you were in the hospital or lost loved ones. I have shared rites of passage. I have shared good times and bad. I cherish that you opened your homes, hearts, and lives with me.

Temple Sinai has been a sacred place for me and for my family as well. Its bimah was a holy obstacle for me to climb for the truly "High" Holy Days of 2018,

when I was injured and had just had extensive surgery on my broken ankle-only achieved with the help of modern pain medication! The bimah has also been a blessing to my family during our rites of passage. Not only did I officiate at weddings and B'nai mitzvah upon it; I experienced them. My own chuppah stood there five years ago, and my sons' joint B'nai Mitzvah service was celebrated there a little over two years ago. Our family's names are etched in the stone walkway leading to the front door of the synagogue, and our names adorn the Joy of Torah, Torah of our Lives, and the L'dor Vador Walls. It was a unique experience to be part of designing some of these installations with the artists, and now it is especially meaningful to know that they remain with the community I have loved for these years. I will never forget the gifts of your kindness and friendship to

my family through all of these times.

As I continue onward on my rabbinic journey, I will be the new rabbi for Conservative Temple Beth El of West Palm Beach. I will remain in contact with Temple Sinai, and I would welcome hearing from any of you periodically about how you are doing.

Serving Temple Sinai has truly been one of the highlights of my rabbinic career to date. May Temple Sinai's eternal light never wane and may all of you go from strength to strength.





What is pluralism? I asked myself this when I was looking to transfer to my new Jewish seminary and found the Academy for Jewish Religion, AJR. Coming from Hebrew Union College, the seminary affiliated with the Union for Reform Judaism, I was curious to read the description on AJR's website that said that it ordains both rabbis and cantors "who combine their mastery of the intellectual and spiritual richness of our tradition with openness to its application in the pluralistic, contemporary Jewish community, and an awareness of living in the presence of God." This idea of pluralism, or "a system in which two or more states, groups, principles…coexist," was intriguing. I was sold on AJR when I read that their graduates "serve both movement-affiliated and non-affiliated congregations in North America and around the world."

The majority of my studies during my four years at HUC were dedicated to the application of Jewish music traditions in the Reform movement, but I felt there was missing something. Over the past few trimesters at AJR I have taken classes focusing more on rabbinic skills. In this modern approach to Jewish studies, I have taken classes like homiletics (the art of writing and delivering sermons) multiple classes in pastoral counseling, peace studies, and entrepreneurship. Not your average course list for a future Reform cantor. I feel truly blessed to be here at Temple Sinai where I can apply these skills in new and interesting ways such as our recent Pesach morning service where I included the T'filat Tal or Prayer for Dew normally only prayed in more traditional congregations. You all have given me a place to grow in ways I did not know I could two years ago. I look forward to see what is coming next.

Please know that during this transitional time, Temple Sinai, with your help, will continue to be the warm and welcoming place that draws you into worship, educational and social programs.

It's encouraging to see that some of our members have been enjoying in person services and activities again. We hope more of you who are able, will get re-acquainted with the good feelings that come with attending Shabbat services in the sanctuary and schmoozing at the Oneg.

We're grateful we are able to provide our worship services virtually. We know it can be a lifeline for those who cannot attend in person. But there is no comparison with the warmth of greeting people face to face, praying together and enjoying a small nosh afterward. To enhance the Friday night experience, plans are in progress for a Shabbat Dinner in June, and musicians at some Onegs throughout the summer, so please watch for more details. Also, our Shabbat Choir will be singing on May 20<sup>th</sup> and more often going forward.

An important lesson from the past couple of years is that the friendly relationships and camaraderie you build with other people are what makes Temple Sinai special. With this in mind, we encourage you to participate in at least one of the "Getting to Know You" Zoom sessions every other Thursday night.

This is a new way for members to learn about their fellow congregants. Those who have attended are glad they did and often return to meet more people! One participant summed it up by saying, "Now I know not only names and faces, but also something about you to say hello to people when I attend Friday night."

Watch for the Zoom invitation in your email every other Thursday. No reservations required, no commitment beyond one hour or so on that Thursday night. (But you are welcome to attend more than once). Those who show up are greeted and given the simple instructions. Then everyone "magically" ends up in small "breakout rooms" with a prompt to discuss, such as "What song brings back the most memories for you?" "What is your favorite hobby these days?" The answers you hear may surprise you. You also might find people who share your interests or ideas or come from your hometown.

Our member, Barbara Weinberg, makes it simple for the participants to be whisked into a few different groups throughout the hour. Many thanks to Barbara, for putting this idea into action!

We also hope to schedule some small casual weekday afternoon gatherings in the Social Hall to schmooze during the summer months.

We will keep you informed of progress in the search for a one-year interim Rabbi in collaboration with our advisors from the Union for Reform Judaism. Both of us remain available to respond to your questions and ideas to contribute to the success of Temple Sinai.

One of the privileges of membership at Temple Sinai is to receive an Aliyah. Aliyot are given to all members to celebrate a birthday, graduation, anniversary, a bris or birth, a wedding, a B'nai Mitzvah, or for any special occasion.

#### **TORAH READINGS & ALIYOT**

Reading Torah - is an extraordinary privilege and a joyous gift.

Aliyot - an aliyah is the honor of standing by the Torah when it is read and reciting the blessings before and after the reading.

## OTHER HONORS FOR WHICH CONGREGANTS MAY BE CALLED TO THE BIMAH ARE:

Petihah - the honor of opening and closing the Ark.

Gelilah - the honor of rolling up the Torah, fastening the belt, and replacing the Torah mantle and crown.

Hagbah - the honor of lifting the Torah and holding it open and upright for the congregation to see.

Shabbat Candle Lighting - the honor of leading the congregation in reciting the candle blessing.

Kiddush - the honor of leading the congregation in reciting the blessing over the wine.

Torah Carrier - the honor of holding and carrying the Torah scroll during the Torah procession.

Members participating should feel no obligation to make a contribution. It is our aim to give every member an Aliyah during the year.

When given a Bima Honor, Honor the Bima with appropriate attire. (Due to a safety issue, no flip flops).

After the shares are transferred to our account, we will sell them and credit your account for the net proceeds (after the fees and expenses are paid). If you have stock that you don't want to sell because of the taxes, this is a win/win for both you and Temple Sinai.

You should realize savings even if you don't itemize. If you do, it shouldn't count as income AND you should be able to take the deduction. As with any financial matter, you should consult your own financial representative or tax advisor to see if these techniques will benefit you.


