SAVE ON TAXES?

You can avoid taxes and save money by having a distribution from your Individual Retirement Account (IRA) sent directly to Temple Sinai. The donation can be used to pay dues, towards a temple project or as a general donation (this can be used by the Temple as needed). The funds must be sent as a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD). Contact us about your plans, then ask your IRA trustee or custodian how to proceed.

You can **avoid capital gains** taxes on appreciated shares of stock that you own by donating the shares to Temple Sinai. As above, the money can be used for any temple bill, project or as a general donation.

Contact us and we will give you instructions on what to tell your broker. After the shares are transferred to our account, we will sell them and credit your account for the net proceeds (after the fees and expenses are paid). If you have stock that you don't want to sell because of the taxes, this is a win/win for both you and Temple Sinai.

You should realize savings even if you don't itemize. If you do, it shouldn't count as income AND you should be able to take the deduction. As with any financial matter, you should consult your own financial representative or tax advisor to see if these techniques will benefit you.

Student Cantor Dan is doing a stellar job in serving our spiritual needs in recent weeks. He is also preparing three students for B'nai Mitzvah. We are so grateful for his abilities and willingness to share them with us.

We are thrilled that Rabbi Allison Cohen will be officiating along with Student Cantor Dan Geigerman for High Holy Day worship. The small High Holy Day Rabbi Search Committee (Sue Wexler, Lori Weiss-Woeltjen and Helene Wartel) interviewed several candidates sent to us by the Central Conference of American Rabbis (CCAR) and without question, Rabbi Cohen was the most appropriate choice.

Rabbi Cohen currently serves Holy Cross Health (Hospital) in Fort Lauderdale, Florida as a Certified Clinical Chaplain. Prior to her Certification for Chaplaincy, she served as an Assistant Rabbi and then the Associate Rabbi of Congregation B'nai Israel in Boca Raton, FL. She graduated magna cum laude from Brandeis University with a major in Sociology and a minor in Music and was ordained by Hebrew Union College – Jewish Institute of Religion where she also received her Master's in Hebrew Letters. In rabbinical school, she was honored with the Israel Bettan Memorial Prize for the Most Creative Sermon in the Scheuer Chapel.

Rabbi Cohen and Student Cantor Dan have already begun to collaborate, and we are sure this year's worship will be inspiring, beautiful and memorable.

We have a search in progress for an Interim Rabbi to guide us while we do a thorough search for a permanent (settled) rabbi. An Interim Rabbi's purpose is to work with the congregation to set up the new permanent rabbi for longevity and success.

"An Interim Rabbi is prepared to hit the ground running, leading services, lifecycle events and dealing with the synagogue's transition issues to assess priorities, values and identity," explains Skylar Cohen, Chair of the URJ Conference of Presidents and member of the Union for Reform Judaism (URJ) Strengthening Congregations Team.

Our goal for Temple Sinai is to have a rabbi with all of the important attributes to fulfill your needs, plus the extra training that an interim rabbi receives, to help us identify who we are and how we can best function going forward. This is what is strongly suggested by the CCAR when a congregation is in a transition period.

Why do we describe our current state as a transitional period? Our issues right now include: a lack of new Temple lay leaders in the pipeline, many members who are either unable to worship in person or have changed their habits and prefer to worship at home and need to be re-engaged and financial challenges. Most of the above are due to Covid, but regardless of the reason, with the help of a trained Interim Rabbi, we hope to find solutions.

We want a permanent rabbi to be able to concentrate on leading worship, teaching, pastoral care, lifecycle events and not have to try to fix the issues above at the same time. To repeat, we want to set up our future permanent rabbi for longevity and success.

An interim rabbi will also be a guide as we search for a permanent (settled) rabbi. We are grateful to have the advice, assistance and wisdom of the CCAR and the Union For Reform Judaism's professionals in this most important task. Please understand, our success will all depend on the availability of suitable candidates. We will keep you informed on the interim search and the plans for the search for a permanent rabbi next year.

the Road! What does a bookie (librarian) do on an extended road trip? High on the list is I always brake for book sales! You never know what gems you will find. But on this particular road trip, I planned a stop in Amherst, Massachusetts, a lovely college town in the Berkshires with lots of interesting history, museums, not to mention gorgeous scenery. This trip was planned with a special stop in mind. From the many book donations received at our library, I had accumulated a number of Yiddish language books which I would ordinarily have shipped to the Yiddish Book Center in Amherst. This time, I was determined to hand deliver them and take a tour of this incredible place. If you do know about the Yiddish Book Center, I highly recommend reading about its founding In a book written by Aaron Lansky. He is the founder and author of the book, entitled "Outwitting History." It's a great read and it is available in our own Temple Sinai Library.

The opportunity to actually present these books in person and explore the exhibits there was defi-

nitely worth the trip. There was a wonderful photographic exhibit of pre-war European synagogues which no longer exist as well as information on the history of the Book Center and all the projects which they have undertaken in not only collecting Yiddish books, but also translating and digitizing them and make them available on line to all of us FOR FREE. We had wonderful conversations with several of the volunteers and staff and an opportunity to explore the collection. Of course, I could not resist a visit to their book store and purchased a couple of books for our own library. The building which is on the lovely campus of Hampshire College is contemporary in style, but also reminiscent of Architecture of the shtetl. All in all, a wonderful experience.

Now that I am back in my library cocoon, I look forward to seeing you all at my second home in the Temple Sinai Library.

AN ALIYAH Is an honor.

One of the privileges of membership at Temple Sinai is to receive an Aliyah. Aliyot are given to all members to celebrate a birthday, graduation, anniversary, a bris or birth, a wedding, a B'nai Mitzvah, or for any special occasion.

TORAH READINGS & ALIYOT

Reading Torah - is an extraordinary privilege and a joyous gift.

Aliyot - an aliyah is the honor of standing by the Torah when it is read and reciting the blessings before and after the reading.

OTHER HONORS FOR WHICH CONGREGANTS MAY BE CALLED TO THE BIMAH ARE:

Petihah - the honor of opening and closing the Ark.

Gelilah - the honor of rolling up the Torah, fastening the belt, and replacing the Torah mantle and crown.

Hagbah - the honor of lifting the Torah and holding it open and upright for the congregation to see.

Shabbat Candle Lighting - the honor of leading the congregation in reciting the candle blessing.

Kiddush - the honor of leading the congregation in reciting the blessing over the wine.

Torah Carrier - the honor of holding and carrying the Torah scroll during the Torah procession.

Members participating should feel no obligation to make a contribution. It is our aim to give every member an Aliyah during the year.

When given a Bima Honor, Honor the Bima with appropriate attire. (Due to a safety issue, no flip flops).


