TORAH READINGS & ALIYOT

Reading Torah - is an extraordinary privilege and a joyous gift.

Aliyot - an aliyah is the honor of standing by the Torah when it is read and reciting the blessings before and after the reading.

OTHER HONORS FOR WHICH CONGREGANTS MAY BE CALLED TO THE BIMAH ARE:

Petihah - the honor of opening and closing the Ark.

Gelilah - the honor of rolling up the Torah, fastening the belt, and replacing the Torah mantle and crown.

Hagbah - the honor of lifting the Torah and holding it open and upright for the congregation to see.

Shabbat Candle Lighting - the honor of leading the congregation in reciting the candle blessing.

Kiddush - the honor of leading the congregation in reciting the blessing over the wine.

Torah Carrier - the honor of holding and carrying the Torah scroll during the Torah procession.

Michele said, "do not over do your volunteer commitments because you are with me kid and I don't want to see you get burnt out." I became her Co-President. At that time, I was still going through my divorce, and it became a bit much to take on the responsibility. So, I backed out. But I still helped Michele behind the scenes for the rest of the time. Michele would call me on the holidays and say come to our house as nobody should be alone on the holiday's. Every year she would ask me to join her and Eugene. She always spoke about her great nephews and was gleaming with a huge smile on her face, they were her grandchildren. I was privileged to have Michele as one of my closest friends. She was a wonderful confident and gave solid advice. She was funny and loved watching Tennis and playing Harry Potter online. If her computer went down, I would rush over to her house and fix it because that is what friends do when you know that their favorite game is off-line. I could write on and on about Michele Levy but there is just so much room in my Newsletter.

As we get close to Passover, I will be thinking of Michele and all the wonderful times we had together. My dear friend you left this earth too early. Thank you for showing me the ropes of Sisterhood.

We also welcome help with our projects and events. Please let us know if something interests you!



SAVE ON TAXES?

You can avoid taxes and save money by having a distribution from your Individual Retirement Account (IRA) sent directly to Temple Sinai. The donation can be used to pay dues, towards a temple project or as a general donation (this can be used by the Temple as needed). The funds must be sent as a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD). Contact us about your plans, then ask your IRA trustee or custodian how to proceed.

You can **avoid capital gains** taxes on appreciated shares of stock that you own by donating the shares to Temple Sinai. As above, the money can be used for any temple bill, project or as a general donation.

Contact us and we will give you instructions on what to tell your broker. After the shares are transferred to our account, we will sell them and credit your account for the net proceeds (after the fees and expenses are paid). If you have stock that you don't want to sell because of the taxes, this is a win/win for both you and Temple Sinai.

You should realize savings even if you don't itemize. If you do, it shouldn't count as income AND you should be able to take the deduction. As with any financial matter, you should consult your own financial representative or tax advisor to see if these techniques will benefit you.
