RABBI'S MESSAGE

In a very interesting book, for those who are students of Kabbalah, entitled "Seekers of the Face", I came across the following teaching, "If human beings do not hold on tight to the cord of divinity in our world, the kite of the Divine will lift off, disappearing into the sky of the infinite" (p. 353). I loved this quote and wanted to share it with you because it really captures the power of the teachings of the Kabbalah that inform us that we, by our thoughts, words, and actions, have the ability and opportunity to bring God into this universe of ours or not. Such a teaching places a tremendous responsibility on each of us, one which

most of mankind is currently failing to take on.

We here at Temple Sinai are not shrugging off this responsibility, however. The number of congregants and friends who are attending services or streaming is most impressive. So many of you have been attending the various programs on Sundays which offer a marvelous and enjoyable way to learn from others various topics of interest and value. Finally, quite a few of you are coming to the many and varied adult education opportunities that are being offered from my classes on Basic Judaism and Kabbalah, Cantor Dan's classes on Talmud and music, and Helene Wartel's Hebrew class. More classes will be announced as we move into the spring.

At my previous congregation on Long Island, the month of February was a very quiet month as no one wanted to go out into the cold. Here in South Florida, we, thank God, do not have that concern. Just look at the calendar and you will see all the things going on at Temple Sinai in February as

well as what we anticipate as we look to March.

As we look forward to March, please take note of the joyous and fun holiday of Purim on Sunday March 24th. We are still working on the plans for what we will be doing that day for the celebration of the Book of Esther, but it will definitely be a day to remember.

On Sunday March 10th I hope you will be joining Judy and me as we and our Temple Sinai celebrate my 50th year since ordination as a Rabbi from Hebrew Union College-Jewish Institute of Religion. The event is called Heart of Gold and will also celebrate this amazing congregation that gives so much to members and to the community-at-large. Someone recently said to me that they would have to believe that I was born to be a Rabbi. In reflection on her words, I would have to answer yes. Let me share with you the following that I was asked to write as a part of the celebration of my class of 1974 to be held at both the annual conventions of the National Association of Retired Reform Rabbis and the Central Conference of American Rabbis.

'A Blessed, Holy Reward': Rabbi Steven Moss on 50 Years in the Reform Rabbinate

My journey as a rabbi started at the age of twelve when I wrote a letter to Hebrew Union College–Jewish Institute of Religion, at that time located on West 68th Street in NYC. I wrote to the college letting it know that I was ready to start my rabbinic studies. The school, of course, wrote back to me saying that I needed to apply after graduation from college. What was amazing was that at my interview, they took out that letter that I had written many years before.

There were many influences in my life that led to my writing that letter. I always had spiritual interests. Prayer was a part of my personal life from my earliest years. I did go to Hebrew school for many years and was active in the choir and Temple life. Although my grandmother's grandfather, Rabbi Wolf Zev Turbowitz, lived during the nineteenth to early twentieth centuries, I do believe that he had a spiritual influence on my life.

His picture hung on my grandmother's Brooklyn apartment wall. As I would pass by, I could feel his presence not only in the room but in my life. Over the years, I have been able to obtain many of his books, as well as handwritten manuscripts. I even visited his grave in Kraziai, Lithuania, where he served as Av Beit Din.

In many ways, the directions of my rabbinate were set during my seminary years at HUC-JIR. During

my second year, I became chaplain at Memorial Sloan-Kettering Cancer Center in Manhattan where I remained as chaplain until 2000. During my third year, I took a student pulpit in Oakdale, Long Island, serving B'nai Israel. I retired from B'nai Israel forty-seven years later.

In 1975, my wife Judy and I moved to Long Island. I became very involved in community activities, including serving three times as president of the Suffolk County Board of Rabbis, and chair of the Suffolk County Jewish Community Coordinating Council.

One of the most engaging parts of my rabbinate started in 1986 when I became chaplain to the Suffolk County Police Department. In 2019, I was named Chief Chaplain Emeritus and truly enjoyed serving the community in this capacity.

I also served the Suffolk County community as chair of the Suffolk County Human Rights Commission from 1991 to 2019, and chair and founder of the Suffolk County Anti-Bias Task Force. I also founded an important program called STOPBIAS which educated over 500 defendants, both juvenile and adult, who had committed bias or hate crimes.

In 2019, I retired from B'nai Israel. Judy and I continued our life in Boynton Beach, Florida, in a home we had purchased many years before. During the next three years, which were those COVID years,

I spent the time studying, teaching on Zoom, and publishing three books. In 2022, however, the opportunity came along to take a pulpit here in Florida, in Delray Beach. I applied to Temple Sinai for the position, and I recently signed a multi-year contract. I also serve as chaplain to the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office and the Delray Beach Police Department. I guess I could say I got tired of retirement.

Looking back over these past fifty years since ordination, I can say I have absolutely no regrets. Many times, during my career, I could have left the congregational rabbinate and taken on a full-time position as chaplain, but I did not. There is truly something blessed, holy, and rewarding about being a pulpit rabbi. One has the incredible opportunity to become intimately involved in the lives of congregants during the most joyous, as well as most sad moments of life.

I have no doubt about the influences my parents had on my life, but none of this would have been possible without the support and love of my soulmate, my wife Judy. We met in high school, and it is she who has been my guiding star to help me on this journey for which I am blessed to have taken.

I do believe the journey is not over. I am looking forward to whatever lies ahead.

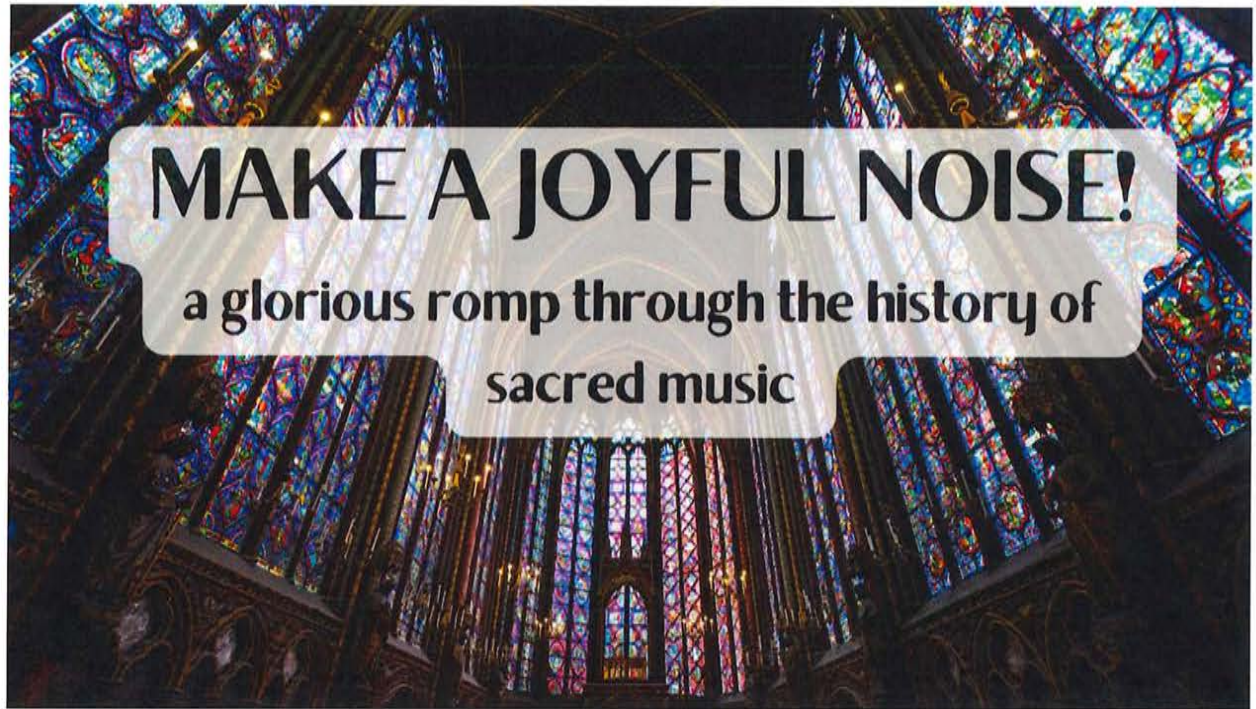

One of the privileges of membership at Temple Sinai is to receive an Aliyah. Aliyot are given to all members to celebrate a birthday, graduation, anniversary, a bris or birth, a wedding, a B'nai Mitzvah, or for any special occasion.

TORAH READINGS & ALIYOT

Petihah - the honor of opening and closing the Ark.

Gelilah - the honor of rolling up the Torah, fastening the belt, and replacing the Torah mantle and crown.

Hagbah - the honor of lifting the Torah and holding it open and upright for the congregation to see.

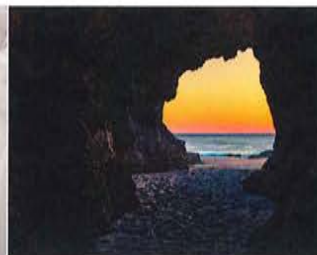

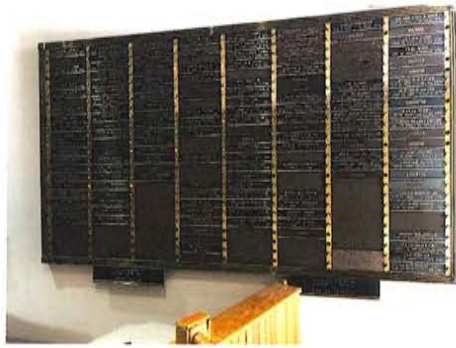

SAVE ON TAXES?

You can **avoid taxes and save money** by having a distribution from your Individual Retirement Account (**IRA**) sent directly to Temple Sinai. The donation can be used to pay dues, towards a temple project or as a general donation (this can be used by the Temple as needed). The funds must be sent as a Qualified Charitable Distribution (**QCD**). **Contact us** about your plans, then ask your IRA trustee or custodian how to proceed.

You can **avoid capital gains** taxes on appreciated shares of stock that you own by donating the shares to Temple Sinai. As above, the money can be used for any temple bill, project or as a general donation.

Contact us and we will give you instructions on what to tell your broker. After the shares are transferred to our account, we will sell them and credit your account for the net proceeds (after the fees and expenses are paid). If you have stock that you don't want to sell because of the taxes, this is a win/win for both you and Temple Sinai.

You should realize savings even if you don't itemize. *If you do, it shouldn't count as income AND you should be able to take the deduction.* As with any financial matter, you should consult your own financial representative or tax advisor to see if these techniques will benefit you.

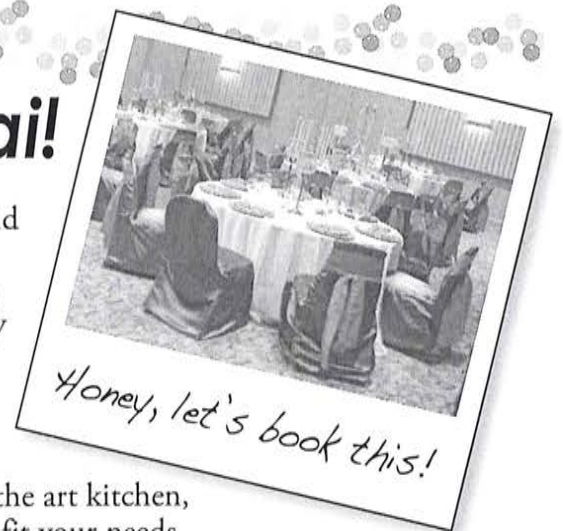
