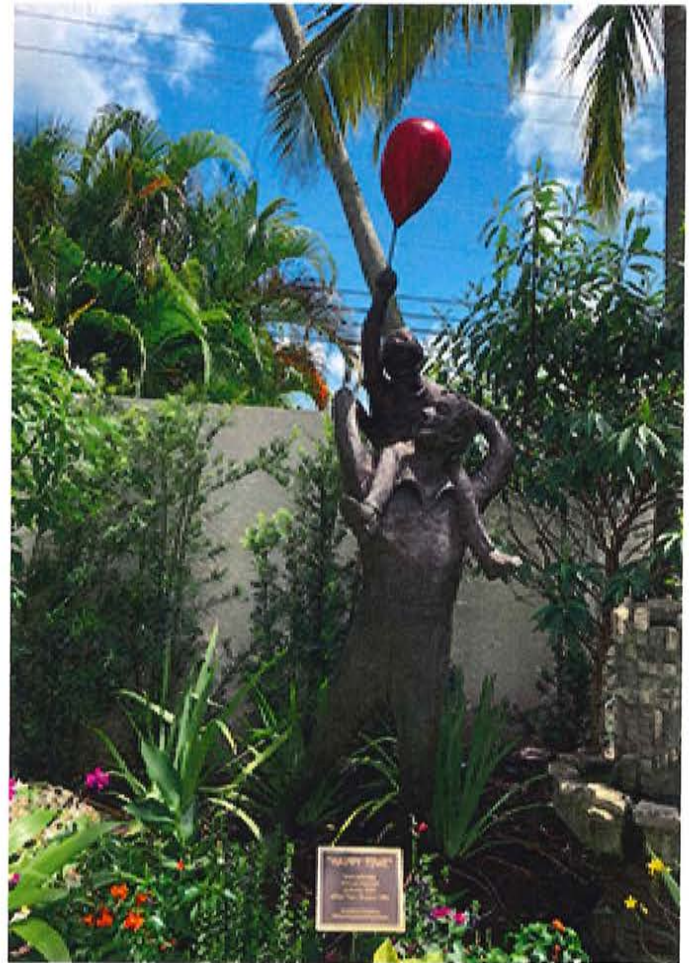

RABBI'S MESSAGE

Dear Temple Sinai Members and Friends,

Summer is upon us. I know many of you will be traveling, so I wish all who are a very safe and enjoyable time wherever you are headed. I am still basking in the joy and inspiration of our dedication ceremony of the two magnificent statues, "Hope" and "Happy Time" that adorn our Temple's property. In spite of the rain that day, it was a wonderful day as the donor, Millicent Rudolph, and many members of her family, my friend Paul Haines, who donated much of the installation, and Jay of Boca Towing, were present along with many Temple members. We are most fortunate that God has blessed the Temple in so many ways including our receiving these wonderful gifts.

Please keep in mind that just as God does not go on vacation, neither does

Temple Sinai. Shabbat services both on Friday nights and Saturday mornings will continue throughout the summer. My Zohar class will continue but only on the weeks that I am in Florida. This is the time for you to be speaking to your friends and neighbors, who are not affiliated with a synagouge, about our Temple Sinai. Invite them to services. Tell them about all our religious, educational, social and cultural programs throughout the year. We want to restore Temple Sinai back to the large number of members that we had before COVID. In order to do this we need you to be our ambassadors; yes, our salespersons.

Please put on your calendars Monday night August 12th. On that night the Temple will observe Tisha B'Av. I truly never understood why so many Reform congregations do not observe this day. While a person might not fast, it was and is the most tragic one day (before October 7th) in our people's history. After all, on this day in 586 BCE the First Temple in Jerusalem was destroyed by the Babylonians and the second Temple in 70 CE by the Romans. But imagine, also on this day the following occurred:

- The First Crusade officially commenced on 15 August 1096 (Av 24, AM 4856), killing 10,000 Jews in its first month and destroying Jewish communities in France and the Rhineland.
- The Jews were expelled from England on 18 July 1290 (Av 9,

AM 5050).

- The Jews were expelled from France on 22 July 1306 (Av 10, AM 5066).
- The Jews were expelled from Spain on 31 July 1492 (Av 7, AM 5252).
- Germany entered World War I on 1–2 August 1914 (Av 9–10, AM 5674), which caused massive upheaval in European Jewry and whose aftermath led to World War II and the Holocaust.
- On 2 August 1941 (Av 9, AM 5701), SS commander Heinrich Himmler formally received approval from the Nazi Party for "The Final Solution," which marked the beginning of the Holocaust during which almost one third of the world's Jewish population was murdered.
- On 23 July 1942 (Av 9, AM 5702), the mass deportation of Jews from the Warsaw Ghetto to Treblinka began.
- The AMIA bombing on the Jewish community center in Buenos Aires, killed 85 and injured 300 on 18 July 1994 (10 Av, AM 5754).
- The 2005 Israeli disengagement from Gaza.

Please join Cantor Dan and I as we observe this day with a very moving and educational evening.

I wish all a safe and beautiful summer. Please remember to let me know of illness and if anyone passes away in your family.

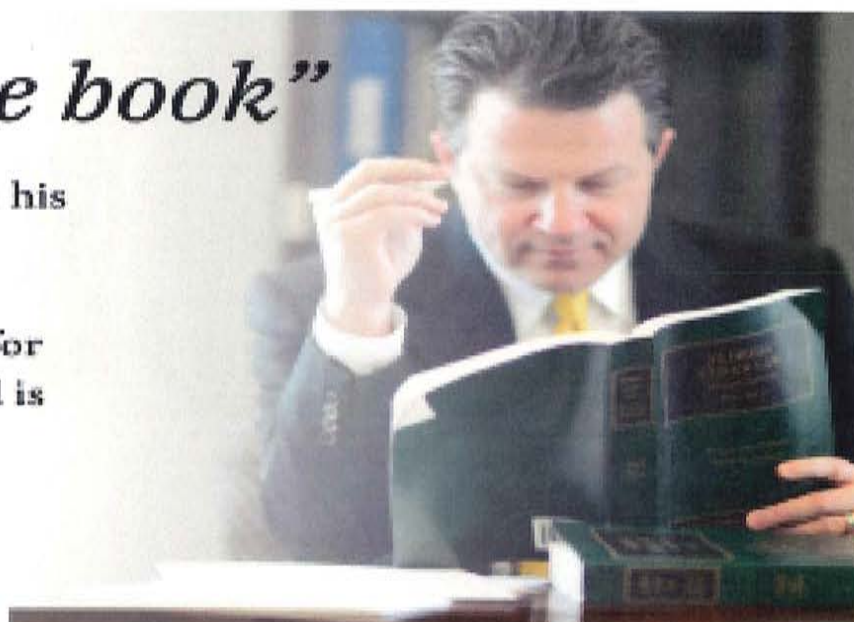

One of the privileges of membership at Temple Sinai is to receive an Aliyah. Aliyot are given to all members to celebrate a birthday, graduation, anniversary, a bris or birth, a wedding, a B'nai Mitzvah, or for any special occasion.

TORAH READINGS & ALIYOT

Reading Torah - is an extraordinary privilege and a joyous gift.

Aliyot - an aliyah is the honor of standing by the Torah when it is read and reciting the blessings before and after the reading.

OTHER HONORS FOR WHICH CONGREGANTS MAY BE CALLED TO THE BIMAH ARE:

Shabbat Candle Lighting - the honor of leading the congregation in reciting the candle blessing.

Kiddush - the honor of leading the congregation in reciting the blessing over the wine.

Torah Carrier - the honor of holding and carrying the Torah scroll during the Torah procession.

Petihah - the honor of opening and closing the Ark.

Gelilah - the honor of rolling up the Torah, fastening the belt, and replacing the Torah mantle and crown.

Hagbah - the honor of lifting the Torah and holding it open and upright for the congregation to see.

Members participating should feel no obligation to make a contribution.

It is our aim to give every member an honor during the year.

SAVE ON TAXES?

You can **avoid taxes and save money** by having a distribution from your Individual Retirement Account (**IRA**) sent directly to Temple Sinai. The donation can be used to pay dues, towards a temple project or as a general donation (this can be used by the Temple as needed). The funds must be sent as a Qualified Charitable Distribution (**QCD**). **Contact us** about your plans, then ask your IRA trustee or custodian how to proceed.

You can **avoid capital gains** taxes on appreciated shares of stock that you own by donating the shares to Temple Sinai. As above, the money can be used for any temple bill, project or as a general donation.

Contact us and we will give you instructions on what to tell your broker. After the shares are transferred to our account, we will sell them and credit your account for the net proceeds (after the fees and expenses are paid). If you have stock that you don't want to sell because of the taxes, this is a win/win for both you and Temple Sinai.

You should realize savings even if you don't itemize. *If you do, it shouldn't count as income AND you should be able to take the deduction.* As with any financial matter, you should consult your own financial representative or tax advisor to see if these techniques will benefit you.

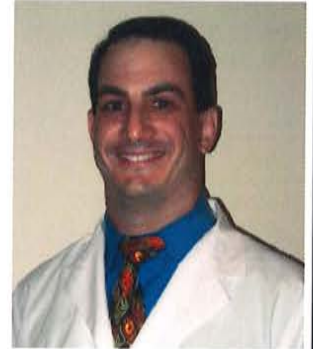

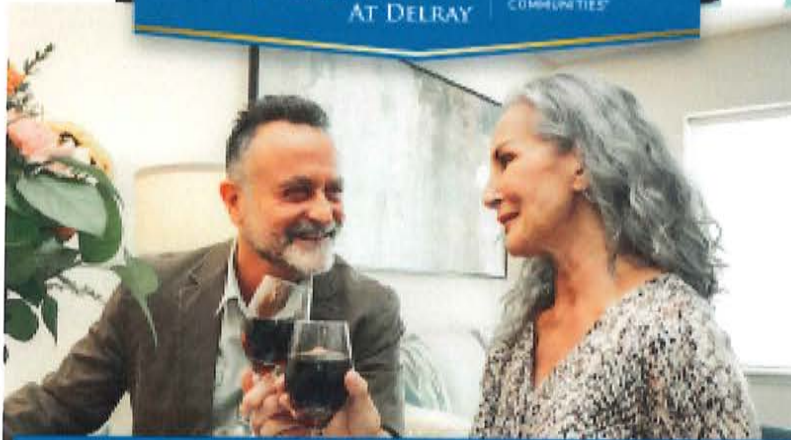

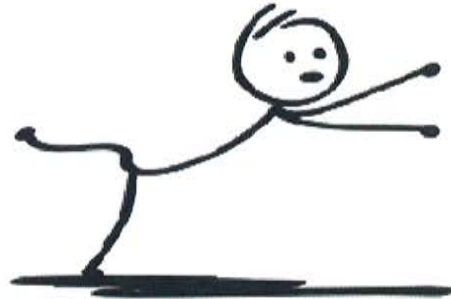
