



RABBI'S MESSAGE

Dear Temple Sinai Members and Friends,

As I write this message, I join with all of you in anticipation of the delicious Thanksgiving holiday that is quickly approaching. Surely, as Jews we do not give thanks to God for our blessings but once a year on the fourth Thursday of November. We are commanded to offer a minimum number of one hundred blessings of thanksgiving a day. There is, of course, something incredibly special about the American holiday of Thanksgiving with its sumptuous feast of amazingly delectable foods, providing not only a special time for family and friends to gather together but to also furnish long lasting

memories for the future generations. I certainly will never forget the incredible smells that struck me as I walked into my Grandma Paula's in Brooklyn. I will always remember watching my Dad, who every year was called upon to do his magic of cutting up the Turkey and then placing all of the pieces back on the bone; memories of Thanksgivings long past for which I shall always be grateful.

We, as a Jewish community, also look forward to the joyous celebration of Chanukah, whose first night candle is lit at sundown of December 25th, that's right, Christmas Day. The last time these two holidays were celebrated on the same day was 2005. I find it wonderful that we can share traditions whose goal is to bring light, joy, and faith into the world. I believe that this year Chanukah will hold special meaning as the Israel Defense warriors are our modern-day Maccabees, fighting Israel's surrounding enemies to survive. Please join the temple for all its special Chanukah events, from the Chanukah

party on Saturday night December 28th to the Delray Beach community Menorah lighting at School House Square on Sunday night the 29th.

I do need to take some space to reflect on the year past, as this is the first Tablet of the new Jewish year 5785. As I begin my third year with Temple Sinai, I must look back on the year past with much gratitude to so many for all that was accomplished. The Temple membership has increased dramatically thanks to the arduous work of Membership Committee co-chairs, Joan and Stan Rieger, and their many helpers who have made Temple Sinai so very welcoming. There is no question that something special is happening here at Temple Sinai. There are so many social, cultural, educational, and spiritual programs being offered and well-attended.

A special thank you to co-Presidents Lynne Weinstein and Betti Adams, who continue to do so much to lead the congregation. I want to offer much thanks to all Temple Board members, committee members and the office staff of Mark, Sima, and Judith. I also appreciate sharing the Bimah with our wonderful Cantor Dan.

This will be a special year for him, as he will become an ordained Cantor. Finally, a special thank you to our wonderful volunteer choir and accompanist Dr. Dave.

Surely, none of us will forget the wonderfully inspiring sculptures, Hope and Happy Time, which embrace the Temple property. Thank you to Millicent Rudolph and family for donating the statues, and to Paul Haines who helped fund their transportation and installation.

The incredible work of the Anti-Bias Coalition of Delray Beach will continue. There is no question that this group will make a significant impact on the quality of life in our city. I cannot tell you how impressed I have been by Eric Adams and his Sandwich Group which reaches out to the Unhoused Community. They are truly fulfilling the beautiful directive of Isaiah: "learn to do good, seek justice, strengthen the robbed, perform justice for the orphan and plead the case of the widow" (Is 1:16,17) I personally want to thank all those who have assisted me in bringing Shabbat and the holidays to Harbor's Edge, and in addition, a thank you to all the Ritual Committee members for their work.

Temple Sinai is making the Jewish ordinary Extra-Ordinary!!! Despite all these positives, there are still so many challenges ahead for Temple Sinai and the Jewish community both here and throughout the world.

The mainstream Jewish community, and particularly our Reform movement, face tremendous challenges. During this past year, many in the Reform movement were trying to figure out how to stem the tide of un-affiliation and disinterest in the traditional Jewish congregational community, particularly by younger people and their families. Even though there are colleagues who disagree with me. I believe that the Reform movement must offer more in terms of spiritual growth and development within congregational settings. When God's presence lives within a congregation, then that congregation will thrive. We need programs that care for and support of individuals yearning to express their Jewish soul by living a Jewish life. The current growth of the Chabad movement gives evidence to the correctness of my thoughts.

Judaism and Jewish life need shots in the arm. A synagogue, near my former congregation on Long Island, had a few million dollars in the bank and yet had less than 20 member families. It folded. There are so few rabbis applying

for entry into the rabbinic program of the Hebrew Union College, that they are ending the in-house rabbinic program at the Cincinnati, Ohio, campus which was founded in 1875 by Rabbi Isaac Meyer Wise.


The alarms are sounding. The challenges are great. The shofar is calling us to wake up, recognize these challenges that are facing the Jewish community at large, and the Reform Jewish community, and do something about them before it is too late.

Temple Sinai is on the right track. As we have now entered the new year 5785, may we continue to stay on the right track with the same vigor, open arms and welcoming words that have become a hallmark of this Temple. May the Holy One, blessed be He, bless Temple Sinai, its officers, and members, with continued strength and inspiration to make this year even better than the one before it.

Happy Thanksgiving. Happy Chanukah. Happy New Year 2025.



TORAH READINGS & ALIYOT

Reading Torah - is an extraordinary privilege and a joyous gift.

Aliyot - an aliyah is the honor of standing by the Torah when it is read and reciting the blessings before and after the reading.

OTHER HONORS FOR WHICH CONGREGANTS MAY BE CALLED TO THE BIMAH ARE:

Shabbat Candle Lighting - the honor of leading the congregation in reciting the candle blessing. Kiddush - the honor of leading the congregation in reciting the blessing over the wine.

Torah Carrier - the honor of holding and carrying the Torah scroll during the Torah procession.

Petihah - the honor of opening and closing the Ark.

Gelilah - the honor of rolling up the Torah, fastening the belt, and replacing the Torah mantle and crown.

Hagbah - the honor of lifting the Torah and holding it open and upright for the congregation to see.

Members participating should feel no obligation to make a contribution.

It is our aim to give every member an honor during the year.

SAVE ON TAXES?

You can **avoid taxes and save money** by having a distribution from your Individual Retirement Account **(IRA)** sent directly to Temple Sinai. The donation can be used to pay dues, towards a temple project or as a general donation (this can be used by the Temple as needed). The funds must be sent as a Qualified Charitable Distribution **(QCD)**. **Contact us** about your plans, then ask your IRA trustee or custodian how to proceed.

You can **avoid capital gains** taxes on appreciated shares of stock that you own by donating the shares to Temple Sinai. As above, the money can be used for any temple bill, project or as a general donation.

Contact us and we will give you instructions on what to tell your broker. After the shares are transferred to our account, we will sell them and credit your account for the net proceeds (after the fees and expenses are paid). If you have stock that you don't want to sell because of the taxes, this is a win/win for both you and Temple Sinai.

You should realize savings even if you don't itemize. If you do, it shouldn't count as income AND you should be able to take the deduction. As with any financial matter, you should consult your own financial representative or tax advisor to see if these techniques will benefit you.






